

# **SGC Youth Funding Guidelines**

## SGC Mandate & Funding Objectives

- To promote German culture, language, customs, traditions, and interests for the benefit of all Saskatchewan people.
- To support programs which grow and enhance youth involvement in German-Canadian cultural and educational traditions and events.

### Funding Criteria

- Is the project youth oriented;
- Is the project unique;
- The number of eligible applications received;
- Does the program generate and promote a sense of community among young Saskatchewan people of German-speaking backgrounds.

### Eligibility & Ineligibility

- Programs that have already been finished by the time of the application are not eligible.
- Funds may not be used for capital expenditures such as furniture, club house additions, renovations and mortgage pay downs.
- Allowances, wages, administrative costs, organizational deficits, and personal expenses for program participants are not eligible.
- Profit-making activities for commercial gain are not eligible.
- Regular annual general, executive or board meetings of an organization or association are not eligible.

#### **Application Process**

- Deadline for applications: There is no deadline for applications. The program is ongoing.
- The SGC finance committee will review all applications and determine the funding.

#### Follow-up

- SGC and Saskatchewan Lotteries logos (available through the office) and acknowledgment of support must be visible on all communications and promotional materials.
- A final report must be submitted after the completion of the program, including:
  - Follow-up form;
  - Relevant documentation (pictures, newspaper articles, programs, etc.);
  - Original receipts for all expenditures.
