## LOGO OPTIONS

The logo can be used with the official colours, inverted (white), in black or in gray scale.

## SIZING & CLEAR SPACE

The logo must be reproduced at an appropriate size to maintain legibility. Standard measure should be a minimum of the logo should be 0.5". This will guarantee that the text is legible.

The logo and all of its elements must be surrounded by minimum open space from other text, as indicated in the example below. Y is the width of the logo.



**Example:** If Y is 8 cm, then there should be a clear space of 1 cm around the logo.

## IMPROPER USAGE

Except for resizing the logo, other alterations and modifications of the logo are not permitted. Do not outline or add drop shadow.

Do not distort, ensure even scaling.



Do not change colours.



Do not crowd logos.



Do not use full colour logo on green, red or yellow background. Use inverted (white) or black option.
