1:30 p.m. Tour: Saskatchewan Railway Museum & Eaton Internment Camp Exhibition

Join us for a special visit to the Saskatchewan Railway Museum, the largest railway museum in the province, and explore an important chapter of Saskatchewan's history.

The site of the museum was once home to an internment camp where, in 1919, sixty-five people of Ukrainian and German origin were detained as so-called "enemy aliens." Our visit will include the Eaton Internment Camp Exhibition in the museum's Kopko Centre, featuring interpretive panels, artefacts, original artwork, and an interactive video display.

The experience continues with a unique highlight: a ride on a gang car pulled by a speeder to Argo Station. Along the way, knowledgeable guides will share stories and insights into the region's railway history.

The museum also boasts an impressive collection of historic rolling stock, locomotives, streetcars from the Saskatoon Municipal Railway, and dozens of preserved railway buildings, making this an engaging and memorable outing for history enthusiasts and families alike.
